

TOURIST TAX

Milan, like many other cities in Italy and throughout the world, has established a Tourist Tax for tourists and visitors, on the basis of article 4, c.1, Legislative Decree 14.3.2011 n. 23, “Dispositions on fiscal municipal federalism”.

The amount ranges from €. 2,00 to €. 5,00 per night, according to the type, class and number of stars of the establishment.

The establishment must issue a separate receipt, or indicate the amount paid for the Tourist Tax within the invoice.

Under 18-year-olds, the disabled and their helpers are exempt from paying the tax. The staff is bound to provide all necessary information regarding other contemplated exemptions.

There may be a 50% reduction of the Tax for specific periods of the year, if determined by the City Administration.

Revenues from the Tourist Tax will finance actions for the preservation of the city’s artistic heritage and for the improvement of services for all tourists.
